CONFIDENTIALITY POLICY

Your right to privacy and confidentiality is a high priority at Touro University Worldwide. TUV policy on disclosure of information conforms to the university's policies and state and federal law.

Except as noted below, no information regarding a student's disability or use of services will be released to parties outside of TUV without prior written consent:

- ❖ Information may be shared in the course of consultation with or referral to other appropriate professionals, when in the best interest of the student.
- ❖ For the purpose of providing priority registration when appropriate and other academic services which benefit the student, I.D. numbers and those eligible are provided to the Records Office. However, **NO** record of disability appears on any academic transcript or permanent document maintained by the Records Office.
- ❖ For legally mandated audits, I.D. numbers may be provided to the Provost.
- ❖ When required by court order, the specific information requested may be released.
- ❖ In extreme situations where immediate harm to self or others may result, the law may require that essential information be reported to the appropriate parties.
