Student Agreement & Touro University MAC Notice Regarding State License

The MAC Student Agreement & Notice Regarding State License form is a document that must be reviewed and signed off on by all individuals who elect to join the MAC program at TUW, which covers some important areas and disclosures related to educational requirements for the MAC program as well as the Counseling license.

Please read, review, sign your name on the last page, documenting your understanding and agreement with the following:

- 1. I understand that if I do not enroll for the term I am accepted, TUW will discontinue my accepted status in the MAC program, and I must reapply to the program.
- 2. I agree to commit to learning, including promptness, attendance, attentiveness, and active class participation (including submission of assignments by deadlines),
- 3. I understand that if my course grades fall below B- and overall GPA falls below a 3.0 GPA and/or I will be subject to academic probation and/or disqualification from continuing in the program.
- 4. I understand that I am required to engage in courteous and professional conduct on campus and on practicum sites in accordance with the TUW Catalog, Code of Conduct Policy, and the MAC Handbook.
- 5. I understand that in addition to the Learning Management System, e-mail is the primary form of communication for the MAC Program. I agree to update my information in the system or notify the Office of the Registrar and the MAC Director of any change to e-mail, telephone number, and address.
- 6. I understand that I will be periodically evaluated on the Professional Counseling Performance Evaluation.
- 7. I understand that practicum/internship placement is not guaranteed by the MAC program because field agencies determine who will be placed at their agency.
- 8. I understand it is my sole responsibility to know and understand the licensure requirements for my intended state or location of licensure including course requirements and practicum requirements.
- I understand that student code of conduct violation (in Course activities and/or practicum) will be considered in the decision to allow me to continue in the MAC program, which may include sanctions, intervention, and/or disqualification from the program.



- 10. I understand that The MAC program at Touro University Worldwide is accredited by the WASC Senior College and university Commission (WSCUC)
- 11. I understand that Touro University Worldwide is in the process to determine that the MAC program meets the educational requirements for state licensure in Counseling and or Addiction Counseling under the standard degree plan in all states. Refer to the state list below, it is important to regularly follow up with your state to ensure curriculum alignment.
- 12. I understand that Touro University Worldwide has determined that the MAC program (MAC Track) <u>does not</u> meet the educational requirements for state licensure in MAC in the following states: **Utah. New York. Missouri.**
- 13. I understand that students who are applying for licensure are required to designate the state they plan to pursue their licensure upon admission.
- 14. I understand that students accept the risk of their program not aligning with the educational program requirements if the student decides to change from the state originally identified upon admission.
- 15. I understand that it is recommended that students confirm licensure requirements for Counseling and or Addiction Counseling with the licensure board in their local area to ensure the coursework and practicum is accepted by their local licensing board.
- 16. I understand that the MAC team is here to support students with the MAC process and help guide students, but that it is ultimately the responsibility of the student to ensure educational and clinical requirements for licensure.
- 17. I understand that educational requirements for the Counseling and Addiction Counseling license may change at times, resulting in the possibility of additional courses or practicum requirements that may be needed either before or after graduation.
- 18. I understand that Touro University Worldwide has not determined if the MAC program meets the educational requirements for any other states.
- 19. I understand that students not interested in pursuing licensure as an MAC, may decide to pursue a career where they work that does not require a clinical license.
- 20. I understand that if I do not complete the clinical track, TUW will not be able to sign off on any practicum hours towards a specific state's licensure requirements.



- 21. I understand that TUW, the MAC program, the practicum/internship site may require a Background check and the results could negatively impact my ability to complete a practicum.
- 22. I understand that there are special considerations if I am employed at a facility that accepts practicum and internship placement, and my site be carefully vetted and pre-approved by the MAC program Practicum and Internship Coordinator.
- 23. I understand that if consideration is given for my employment facility, the facility must agree to provide me with educationally focused learning opportunities that are different and separate from my regular job responsibilities.
- 24. I understand that appropriate practicum/internship placement is at the discretion of MAC program administrators.
- 25. I understand that Practicum/Internship is a class that requires weekly attendance of a group conference, weekly Supervision at the approved external site, and weekly supervision by the TUW supervisor.
- 26. I understand that practicum and internship supervision must include secure audio or video recordings and/or live supervision that demonstrate interactions with clients complies with applicable institution, state, federal and international privacy requirements.
- 27. I understand that TUW is 100% online and professors are not affiliated to external sites, which means that each session I must use at least one of my Audio/Video recordings from my field placement site or provide a Live Session alternative (for example, session transcriptions) with a client from my placement site.
- 28. I understand that if only live session is done by my site supervisor, I must present an in-class presentation to fulfill my Case Assignment presentation based upon the Live Session alternative (example of alternative is live session transcriptions- students will use Live Session Moment-to-Moment Tracking Transcript form in my IC Portal). The transcription must be signed by my site Supervisor.
- 29. I understand that when enrolled in Practicum/Internship, each student is required to obtain student level liability insurance.
